A child will compete to make the most mouth-watering hamburger with their choice of toppings and bun.

- 1. An entry form and fee of \$25.00 per child must be received by no later than August 18, 2018. Entry form and online payment are also available on our website at www.liveunited.us. The entry fee will supply the contestant with an apron and 1 lb of ground beef. The grill and charcoal will be provided.
- 2. The child will be provided 1lb of ground beef in which to make 2 hamburgers with. The contestant will need to bring their own seasoning/sauces, toppings, buns and cooking utensils including tongs, cutting board etc.
- 3. The child must be between the ages of 6 and 12 to participate. An adult must be with the contestant at all times or they will be disqualified.
- 4. Kids Cook-off contestants must cook in the designated area. Also, each contestant must do the preparation, cooking and presentation.
- 5. Handicapped children will be allowed to do as much as they are able with some help from the parent. Please let us know on the entry form if a handicapped child is participating and what special arrangements need to be made.
